

PRIVACY POLICY

This Data Privacy Notice informs you about how and for which purposes we will process your personal data and explain your rights under applicable data protection. It also sets out your rights in relation to how we look after your personal data. We are strongly dedicated to handling your personal data always responsibly, diligently and in compliance with all legal requirements.

1. Poland Prize is acceleration programme organised by Foundation Startup Hub Poland with Partners under the Grant Agreement with PARP (Polish Agency for Enterprise Development). Project is financed from the sources of the program Start in Poland within the Strategy for Responsible Development and European Funds, 2014-2020.

2. Foundation Startup Hub Poland with a seat in Warsaw (02-541), ul. Ludwika Narbutta 20/33-34, is a personal Data controller of Startups and Participants of Poland Prize. Furthermore, according to current regulations, other entities might be considered the data controller – PARP - Polish Agency for Enterprise Development or some of trusted partners (organisations with which we cooperate, as official program partners and partner organisations).

3. According to the law, we can pass your data to entities, that process the data only for the purposes indicated by us. Such entities include our subcontractors – eg. IT providers, marketing agency. Second group that might have access to it, are people with whom we cooperate within our acceleration programs – judges, mentors, experts. Third group are our trusted partners – part of them will only process your data, eg. in order to conduct the workshops. We may also pass you data to entities eligible to have access to it, based on law, for example courts.

4. Foundation Startup Hub Poland collect your personal data after you provide to us using the forms on our website and recruitment platform and when you start cooperating with us within the program. The scope of data we process differs depending on the purpose – when you register for an Poland Prize you provide us with your name, surname, email address, location, phone number, project name, short description of concept, development stage, business model, team information, professional experience and education, additional presentations.

5. Providing data is voluntary, however failure to submit data marked as necessary to provide the service, will prevent us from providing the service.

6. You have a right of access and the right to rectify the contents of the data concerning him or her. In such case it is required to contact Foundation Startup Hub Poland i.e. electronically at office@startuphub.pl.

7. Every person has a right to control the processing of data concerning him or her, contained in a data collection of the Data controller, and especially the right: to demand that personal data be supplemented, updated, corrected, that their processing be discontinued

temporarily or permanently, or that the data be removed, where the data is incomplete, outdated, untrue, or collected in violation of the Personal Data Protection Act, or are no longer necessary for the purpose, for which they were collected.

8. In case of giving a consent to his or her personal data being processed for a purpose of a direct marketing of the Data controller`s products or services - the consent may be withdrawn at any time.

9. The collected personal data will be processed for the purpose of recruitment, preacceleration and realisation of Poland Prize Programme.

10. In the event of a change of the personal data please contact Foundation Startup Hub Poland i.e. electronically at e-mail address: office@startuphub.pl.

11. Foundation Startup Hub Poland is processing the personal data according with the security requirements predicted by the applicable provisions of law. The Data controller applies technical and organizational measures ensuring the protection of processed personal data commensurate with threats and with categories of data subject to protection, and in particular secures the data against access by unauthorized persons, appropriation by unauthorized persons, processing in violation of the applicable provisions of law in force, and against modification, loss, damage or destruction.

12. If the data subject finds that the processing of his personal data is in breach of applicable law, he has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

13. We will hold your personal data as long as required to provide the services, products or information you have requested and to administer your business relationship with us. If you have asked us not to communicate with you, we will hold this information as long as required to comply with your request.

14. The website may contain links to other websites. The Data collector requires, after entering other websites, to read the privacy policy determined there. This Privacy Policy applies only to recruitment, preacceleration and Acceleration Programme.

15. This Data Privacy Notice was last updated in March 2018. From time to time, we may make change or amend it as required to comply with applicable data protection law.
